The first cycle prepares for a Bachelor's degree in educational sciences, general didactic option.

The second and third cycles cover various fields of study in master's and doctorate

The open training courses are structured around theoretical contributions and convincing results in the field of research in didactics, the preparation and conduct of a research project in the field of didactics. They are also an opportunity to acquire and use transversal skills: mastery of languages (French and English), processing of statistical data, scientific survey methods, communication practices, etc.

The training is provided by a team of dynamic and competent teachers (emeritus professors, lecturers, lecturers and assistants and field professionals) who support students in their research or thesis project.

The supervision and research component is enhanced by multilateral cooperation backed by existing contacts and bilateral or multilateral structures such as UNESCO, Cameroonian and foreign universities, etc.

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

BACHELOR'S DEGRREE IN SCIENCES of EDUCATIONAL OPTION: GENERAL DIDACTIC

The BACHELOR'S degree inSciences of Education is a threeyear course. It allows you to acquire the fundamentals in the fields of teaching and training, Knowledge of the education system has an important place throughout the training


The first five semesters constitute a common core. This is a multidisciplinary portal where for example: The foundations of education, inclusive education, the sociology of education and a lot of psychology: cognitive, social, child development, learning...There are also more specific teaching units such as pedagogy and didactics. Finally, research has an important place in the degree since it is all about educational sciences. We therefore study descriptive and inferential statistics every year, we see different methods of investigation in the human and social sciences and we train in the experimental method and in reading scientific articles.

From the sixth semester onwards, the Department of Didactics of Disciplines offers lessons for an option in General Didactics

In addition to the theoretical knowledge to be acquired in various fields of Educational Sciences, the student develops transversal skills during their training through internships carried out in school, community, and in the workplace.

MASTER IN SCIENCES OF L'EDUCATION SPECIALITY: DIDACTICS

The second cycle addresses various fields of study in the didactics of disciplines.

The Master is built around five principles. This is:

a very diversified training offering which gives students the opportunity to choose between two options studying different fields of education and training; school teaching and learning;

an anchor in the professional world with the existence of internships which train professionals in a specific educational field by alternating field experience and reflective analysis of this experience;

training in research and through research which is structured around theoretical contributions and convincing results in the field of research in the didactics of disciplines while giving the student the opportunity to acquire and use transversal skills such as: mastery of languages (French and English), processing of statistical

data, methods of scientific investigation, communication practices, preparation and conduct of a research project in the fields of didactics disciplinary, interdisciplinary and comparative.


an openness to initial training and continuing training. The training courses are open to both students in initial training and education and training professionals who want to progress in their profession.

The Master aims to acquire a set of knowledge, procedures and methods enabling the student to be able to:

develop skills in study and research on disciplinary and interdisciplinary teaching and learning, in the different contexts where they are practiced;

 train in didactic and pedagogical analyzes of the methods of transmitting knowledge in formal and informal situations.



Conditions d'admission

For admission to master 1:

Hold an academic degree, preferably in the school disciplines taught at preschool, primary and secondary levels

For admission to master 2:

have obtained a General Weighted Average (MGP) greater than or equal to 2.4 and be selected in Master II by a central commission chaired by the Rector of the University of Yaoundé 1.

DOCTORATE IN SCIENCES OF L'ÉDUCATION SPÉCIALTY: DIDACTICS

The third cycle prepares students for specialized fields of study in the diadactics of the discipline.

In the first year, seminars are organized by the Center for Research and Doctoral Training (CRFD) and departmental seminars.

In the second year, a general comprehensive exam is organized. Any candidate declared admitted to the general comprehensive examination must obtain a general weighted average greater than or equal to 2.4 out of 4.

Conditions d'admission

For admission to the 1st year Doctorate:

hold a Master 2 Research in Educational Sciences with a Didactics specialty in a discipline with a General Weighted Average (MGP) greater than or equal to 2.4 and be selected for Master II by a central commission
